Important Water Supply Update – April 24, 2015

The District has completed analysis of the updated United States Bureau of Reclamation 90% (dry year) operations forecast, together with the latest projections for water available from the San Joaquin River. This notice is to confirm that the District's April 5, 2015 allocation will not change.

January through August allocation:

Tier 1 - USBR	21.25"/acre
Tier 2 – CCID Wells	5.25"/acre


Unused January through August allocation can be moved to the September through December period.

September through December allocation:

The Tier 1 depths have not yet been confirmed. The District has been working with Reclamation on the fall allocation schedule. Some fall water will be available and we expect to finalize the schedule of availability within the next 30 days.

We will continue to analyze forecast information and provide updates immediately if any changes are warranted or required. Again, thank you for your active participation this month, and for your patience and understanding through this difficult water year.
