

**CENTRAL CALIFORNIA IRRIGATION DISTRICT  
IMPORTANT UPDATED WATER SUPPLY INFORMATION – APRIL 10, 2014**

On April 9, 2014, the Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) provided their March dry year forecast for San Luis Reservoir and Delta-Mendota Canal operations. Earlier this week, the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) released their runoff forecast for the San Joaquin River. Based on these forecasts CCID and the Exchange Contractors have updated the amount of surface water available for our consumers. Reclamation still projects that they will deliver only a portion of our Critical Year water supply from the Delta-Mendota Canal, and for the first time in history they will deliver San Joaquin River water to us to meet the terms of the Exchange Contract.

Listed below are the new tiered water quantities and the water rate. **Please note the new flexibility provided in the schedule.**

Tier 1 – 2.1 acre-feet/gross acre - \$17.00 /acre-foot

Tier 2 – 0.5 acre-feet/gross acre (CCID Well Water) - \$40.00 /acre-foot

SCHEDULE FOR UPDATES

Please note that the above allocations are based on a 90% hydrology forecast and there are some risks that the amounts could change.

We will update this schedule as information is made available by Reclamation. We are expecting an update from them later this month which will be based on the April 1 DWR snow survey. After that we expect updates to be provided monthly.

SUPPLEMENTAL POOL WATER

Pool 1 (Purchased Well Water) has been allocated to those who signed up. Those consumers are being notified.

With this new estimation of surface water available, we will re-assess the Pool 2 (water generated from set-aside) demand. Consumers who signed up for the program will be contacted to determine their continued interest; deposits will be refunded as requested. We will assess the need to buy water from landowners based on setting aside land; a notice will go out soon.

DEVELOPED WATER –CLASS II LANDS –IMPORTANT NOTICE

**There will be no water available from the District for Class II lands.** We will, however, transport private well water for those who have access to wells that can be pumped into our canals. The water will be subject to a \$2.00 per acre-foot transportation/administrative charge, and a loss factor related to the field's distance from a well source.
