

**CENTRAL CALIFORNIA IRRIGATION DISTRICT
IMPORTANT UPDATED WATER SUPPLY INFORMATION – May 16, 2014**

On May 13, 2014, the Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) announced an update to the February 2014 Central Valley Project water supply for the San Joaquin River Exchange Contractors. Reclamation will meet the critical year demands for the months of April through October and will work throughout the summer to explore the ability to provide additional water as called for under the Exchange Contract. For the Exchange Contractors, these demands will be satisfied by both Delta and for the first time in history San Joaquin River sources for a total of 529,000 acre-feet. Our November water is subject to an allocation by Reclamation – **it is not yet secure.**

Listed below are the new tiered water quantities and the water rate.

Tier 1 – 2.35 acre-feet/gross acre - \$17.00 /acre-foot

Tier 2 – 0.5 acre-feet/gross acre (CCID Well Water) - \$40.00 /acre-foot

FLEXIBILITY

Consumers can pool January through August water together and use it anytime within that period.

Move unused water to September or later.

September through November water may NOT be moved into January through August.

* November water is subject to an allocation by Reclamation – **it is not yet secure.**

SCHEDULE FOR UPDATES

Please note that the above allocations are based on a 90% hydrology forecast and there are some risks that the amounts could change.

We will update this schedule as information is made available by Reclamation. The next Reclamation update will be based on the May 1 DWR snow survey.

SUPPLEMENTAL POOL WATER

Pool 1 (Purchased Well Water) has been allocated to those who signed up.

Pool 2 (Water Generated from Set-aside) has been allocated to those who signed up.

DEVELOPED WATER – CLASS II LANDS – IMPORTANT NOTICE

There will be no water available from the District for Class II lands. We will, however, transport private well water for those who have access to wells that can be pumped into our canals. The water will be subject to a \$2.00 per acre-foot transportation/administrative charge, and a loss factor related to the field's distance from a well source.
