2. **Review of Agenda**

The Board will consider corrections or additions to the agenda of items requiring immediate action that have come to the attention of the District following the posting of the agenda.

6. **On-Farm Water Conservation Program**

One or more conservation projects that have previously received preliminary approval from the Water Conservation Policy Committee will be described and the Board will be asked to approve incentive grants and/or loans for the projects, and to authorize the execution of the loan documents.

8. **Monthly Financial Report**

The Administrative Assistant will present figures through June 30 for water sales, revenues and expenses in comparison to the 2021 budget, receivables, investments, and reserve funds for water conservation loans and projects. No Board action is expected.

9. **Claim for Flood Damages**

The District has received two claims, for the flood damages occurring on December 5, 2020. The Board will be asked to reject the claim, and refer them to ACWA/JPIA for processing:

- a. Osmin Torres Gonzalez for alleged injury and damage of personal belongings in the amount of \$7,500.
- b. Ovidio A. Rivas for alleged injury and damage of personal belongings in the amount of \$7,000.

10. **Resolution No. 21-09**

The Board will review and consider adopting Resolution No. 21-09 approving revisions to the CCID On-Farm Water Conservation Loan and Grant Program Policy.

11. **Repayment Agreement Request – Robert Silva**

Robert Silva has installed a new road crossing to redirect flows through existing ditches and drains for re-use on other properties of his. This road crossing alleviates impacts to his downstream neighbors. The Board will be asked to set the interest rate, approve the repayment agreement for \$14,831.05 and authorize the President and Assistant Secretary to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.

12. **Make-up Time Policy**

The Board will review a draft Make-up Time policy. No Board action is expected.

13. **Legal and Four-Entities Matters**

General Counsel, the Executive Director and the Manager will discuss with the Board current issues affecting the Exchange Contractors and CCID. Board action may be requested on any of these matters.

14. **Miscellaneous Business**

At this time, Board members and staff may discuss matters that are not on the agenda which may affect operations of the District. No Board action is expected to be taken.
