**2. Review of Agenda**

**6. On-Farm Water Conservation Program**

One or more conservation projects that have previously received preliminary approval from the Water Conservation Policy Committee will be described and the Board will be asked to approve incentive grants and/or loans for the projects, and to authorize the execution of the loan documents.

**8. Monthly Financial Report**

The Secretary will present figures through May 31 for water sales, revenues and expenses in comparison to the 2024 budget, receivables, investments, and reserve funds for water conservation loans and projects. No Board action is expected.

**9. Fiscal Year 2024 - Budget Amendment**

The Board will review and consider authorizing additional funding to a specific line item for the 2024 fiscal year budget.

**10. Resolution No. 24-05**

The Board will review and consider approving Resolution No. 24-05 to authorize the Elections Offices of Merced County and Fresno County to include Division 2 (Bloom), Division 3 (Medeiros) and Division 5 (Fontana) whose term expires in December 2024, in the General District Election, to be held on November 5, 2024.

**11. Easement Agreement**

The Board will review and consider approving an easement agreement with the Great Canal Farm, LLC for the Helm Ditch Extension which is owned by the District and traverse the Grantors property.

**12. License Agreement**

The Board will review and consider approving a PG&E license agreement to cross the Shafter Ditch with an overhead electrical power line to serve a pump for C & D Farms. The request meets District engineering standards and the proposed license agreement is in line with District legal and insurance requirements.

**13. Private Well Water Transfer Request**

The Board will review and consider approving a request from Vaquero Farms to discharge private well water into District facilities for water credits in other districts, in conformity with the District's existing policies.

**14. Workplace Violence Prevention Plan**

The Board will review and consider approving the draft Workplace Violence Prevention Plan. The Plan is a newly required and must be in play by July 1, 2024.

**15. Legal and Four-Entities Matters**

General Counsel and the Executive Director will discuss with the Board current issues affecting the Exchange Contractors and CCID. Board action may be requested on any of these matters.
